# Frequently Asked Questions Concerning Student Registration

#### Will my student have the same teacher in hybrid or DL?

To the extent possible, it is our plan/hope to keep class rosters stable. However, we cannot guarantee your student(s) will have the same teacher.

### What are the safety measures for hybrid learning?

Safety measures are guided by the county's colored tier, CDPH, and the district's COVID Safety Plan. Students will be socially distanced (6 feet), will wash/sanitize hands frequently, wear face coverings, will have temperatures taken prior to entering campus, and will be in a stable cohort.

#### Will students be required to have a vaccination?
