Student bus pass applications should be turned in as soon as possible to allow time to process permanent bus passes. Bus passes are required on all buses as of September 12th, 2017, no exceptions. Bus passes are valid for the entire school year.

The following fees remain in effect:

Full price - \$150.00 - Reduced Price for those who qualify \$75.00 - One way to Castle X \$75.00  
The district continues to allow a payment schedule for those parents who request it.  
Single day bus passes: \$1.00 - Book of 10 daily passes - \$8.50 - Single day bus pass to Castle X: \$.50

Lost bus passes, temporary or permanent, full price, reduced-price or free, will be reissued for a fee of \$5.00 per pass. Bus pass stickers used on temporary or permanent school ID cards will be replaced at a charge of \$1.00 each.
