2.1 Approval of Out of State Travel for Band Students to Attend the Western International Band Clinic in Seattle Washington November 19-22, 2010

<u>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</u>: Board approval is required when students travel out of the state on school activities.

<u>CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS</u>: Three students of the Burroughs High School Band auditioned and qualified to attend the Western International Band Clinic in Seattle Washington November 19-22, 2010.
